Dear ECD Parents/Guardians/Caregivers

Welcome back to Term 3.

After the president's speech last night and rising Covid numbers, we have decided that it will be in our pupils' best interest if we do not open the school tomorrow as originally planned.

Even though the school does not open physically, we will continue with online teaching from Wednesday 14 July with the rest of the school. We did it last year with great results and are more than capable of doing it again.

What does this entail?

- Pupils do not come to campus but will receive a daily plan with activities from Monday to Thursday before 08h00 each day.
- These activities can be completed in the safety of their own homes. Videos and photos should be sent to their teachers regularly.
- Any outstanding work can be completed on a Friday since no new work will be sent out.
- The Daily Online Teaching Plan will be sent to you via following platforms: Email, loaded onto the Google Drive for which you will receive a link and posted on MyHomework.
- If Grade R pupils are unable to print or do activities on a laptop, you are welcome to come and fetch a booklet with the Daily Online Teaching Plans and worksheets at school on Tuesday, 13 July between 12h00 and 13h00. This is the exact same information that will be sent to you via email. This is not applicable to Stage 4 and Stage 5 since they do not have any worksheets.
- Pupils will be given a specific time where they will Google Meet with their teachers every few days.
- There will be no assessments done during this time and no marks loaded onto ADAM.
- Teachers are available on email between 08h30 until 12h30 every day from Monday to Friday.
- The office will also be open during these times for any enquiries.

Please keep in mind that this is only temporary and that we will hopefully be able to return to school on Monday, 2 August.
