
As a 30-year-old school, we wish to strengthen our traditions and our relationships with our alumni. A strong alumni body is a reflection of a strong school.

PEPPS is incredibly proud that over the past 8 years we have achieved a PMR Africa Award in the category of Best Private School in Limpopo. This encourages us, as the business community in our province values the work that we are doing.

PEPPS continues to grow in Limpopo and currently has three well-established campuses in Limpopo: PEPPS Polokwane, PEPPS Mokopane and PEPPS Ga-Ledwaba. PEPPS Polokwane recently acquired 8 additional hectares of land which has allowed for further growth and PEPPS Mokopane will be starting a college in 2022.



PEPPS Ga-Ledwaba (just outside Lebowakgomo) now has 5 early childhood development (ECD) classrooms, 15 preparatory classrooms as well as administration buildings. In 2022, they will run from Grade 1-7 for the first time.





PEPPS Mokopane is located on the slope of a hill on the outskirts of Mehwereng. Last year, a new administration building was completed and, the year before, tennis and netball courts were built.



Currently, the Mokopane ECD has 3 classrooms, the preparatory school has 16 classrooms and the school has a lovely thatched hall. We shall be building two new classrooms for the Grade 8s in 2022, which we are exceptionally excited about.

The Polokwane campus has created a tuckshop/canteen in the original Shed, acquired an enormous hall with the purchase of our new land and built 10 new classrooms over the last few years. There are currently 4 ECD class spaces with a modern playground and 10 foundation phase classrooms separately located from the 12 intersen classrooms. The college has 24 classrooms as well as a laboratory, computer room and library space.



There is an auditorium and a music auditorium to allow for the growth of cultural activities at the school and sporting activities are supported by 2 swimming pools, netball/tennis courts and fields.



We really encourage our alumni to come and take a look at the growth that has taken place at your school!

PEPPS Polokwane continues to be recognised as a high performing independent school in Limpopo Province boasting a habitual 100% Matric Pass Rate and over 80% Bachelor Degree Pass Rate, writing the esteemed Independent Examinations Board matric final examinations.


