



The first month of 2022 is gone ... and what a busy month it was!!! It has been so GOOD to be back to a bit of a 'normal' programme.

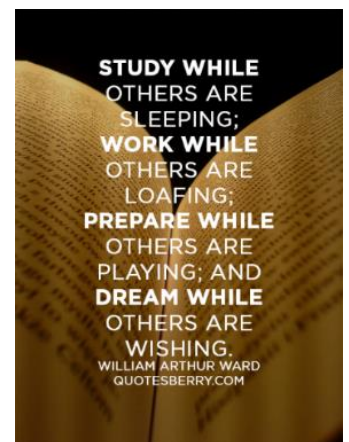

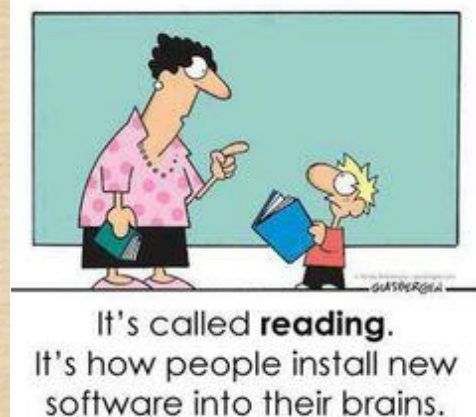
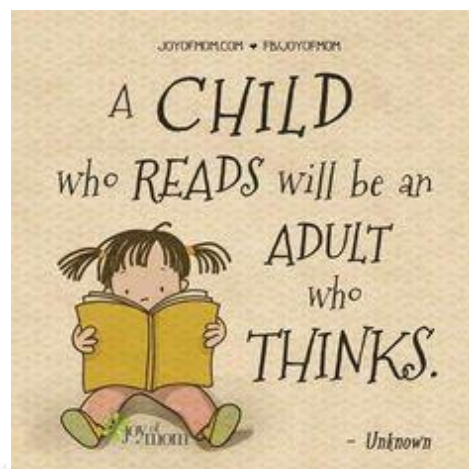
