

June Exams 2022

Examinations occur twice a year, in June and in November. These are our summative assessments during which pupils will show to what extent they have mastered the content and skills they were taught in Terms 1 and 2. We are preparing for this period of exams now and the letter serves to communicate some expectations and logistical information.

Thoughts and expectations around exams...

At PEPPS, we consider 50% to be a pass. Please support your child with time management and organisational skills as they approach exams. Scopes have been made available to pupils in hard copy and on myHomework. It is essential that pupils prepare by means of creating summary notes and using the revision packs that teachers are providing. They must spend time learning and answering practice questions. Each child will receive up to 2% for handing in these notes on the day of the exam.

Each exam contains a variety of question types which will require that the pupils recall some material from memory; demonstrate an understanding of certain concepts; be able to apply their knowledge and analyse and evaluate a host of scenarios. Please question your children on the eve of their exam to evaluate their preparedness. For Grade 4s, this will be their first exam and they will need their hands held through this part of the journey.

Important Dates and Closing Times

- The last day for extra-curricular activities is Friday 3 June.
- From **6-10 June**, lessons can be used for **revision purposes for Grade 4-7**, following the normal school timetable and ending daily at 13h30.
- **Grade 7s** will write exams from **13-17 June** and follow a special timetable on the **20th of June**.
- **Grade 4-6s** will write exams from **13-20 June**.
- From the **13th to the 20th of June**, the school day will run as indicated below. Pupils may go home from 11h40 unless they were in the Top Ten in Term 1 (2022); then they may leave at 09h30. If they are in the choir or hockey, they must go home at 12h30.
- **Grade 1-3** will close at 12h30 during the exam period.
- **Grade 1-7** - Normal school times (ending at 13h30) will commence on Tuesday 21 June.
