The parents will access and follow Google Classroom up to Grade 3. Grade 4s will receive teacher and parental support to become empowered to access and follow for themselves. From Grade 5 upward, pupils should take full ownership of the platform. Parents are encouraged to access Google Classroom with their older children to support them and to keep up-to-date with the work they are doing. The email will include step-by-step instructions on how to join Gmail then subsequently the Google Classroom classes.

PEPPS is an excellent school and, as such, will not cut corners in terms of the number of school days afforded to our pupils annually. We are committed to offering a value-formoney service, and so we will stick to the quota mandated to us. Additionally, we commit to teaching and assessing throughout. Please be reminded of the 2023 term dates. They do differ from other schools and it is important to pay close attention lest your child miss out.

You are invited to attend the "State of PEPPS" address that I will deliver to each campus. The dates and times are below:








The above is a cartoon summary of some of the thoughts form *Raising an Entrepreneur*. It is a fantastic read that I encourage you to try.
