I would like to welcome our new teachers to the school. I wish both of them a prosperous stay at PEPPS.





School Logistics & Reminders

School times: Pupils must gather for line up at 07h25 for announcements. School comes out at 13h30 (Monday to Thursday) and 12h30 (Fridays). Our Extra-curricular programme is offered from Monday to Thursday from 14h00-15h30. The Foundation Phase has its extra-curricular activities integrated into the school day (12h40-13h30). Loitering is UNSAFE and is NOT tolerated. If a child is on campus after school, they are expected to participate in the rich programme OR sit in a homework venue until they are collected. Every child is compelled to participate in at least ONE extra curricular activity per term. Staff are only on duty from 06h45–16h00 daily.

Uniform (including hair, nails and jewellery) checks will be implemented from Monday 16 January. The uniform expectations are clearly outlined on the website (www.pepps.co.za) for a detailed outline of acceptable physical presentation. Penalties will be issued from Monday, 16 January onwards.

House Names have changed: Your child will now belong to either Acacia (white & black), Baobab (blue) or Marula (red). New house names align better with our context and we will spend the next few weeks building house identities and school spirit under new banners.

PEPPS uses **digital platforms to communicate** with parents. Please ensure that you do the following as soon as possible.

1. We are moving away from myHomework and will communicate via **Google Classroom** from 2023. Please expect an email that will provide you with your child's PEPPS email address (Grade 1-7) and password. This will be used to access the respective Google Classrooms (per subject).
