- Must be cognoscente and continue to proceed with caution





- First group to matriculate that had Creating Tomorrow as a Foundation in Gr 8/
- Group hardest hit by Covid-19 hitting their Grade 10-11 year.
- Average: 68%
- Percentage of pupils over 60%: 85.5%
- No one got below 50% average
- Number of pupils with over 80% average: 16%
- Number of pupils with 70-80% average: 23.2%
