The LS teacher identifies pupils with learning difficulties in collaboration with the class teachers and mathematics specialists and develops and implements individualised plans to meet the needs of each pupil/small group, which may include modifying the curriculum, providing additional resources, or adapting teaching methods. The LS Teacher ensures that each student receives the support they need to succeed.
